Requirements:

1. Completion of 4 years of English with an overall GPA of 2.0 in English courses.
2. Achieve "Standard Met" or "Standard Exceeded" on 11th grade CAASPP English exam.
3. You only need to meet ONE of the options below:
 - Pass foreign language AP exam with 3 or better
 - Complete four years of foreign language with overall GPA of 3.0 or better in those classes
 - Pass SAT II Foreign Language with a score of 600
4. Attain Early Advanced or Advanced on the CELDT (For English learners ONLY)
