

# PARENT TIPS FOR DISTANCE LEARNING SUCCESS



## Designated Work Space

Create a designated work space for distance learning. Students will achieve their best work in a quiet, comfortable, dedicated space devoted to learning. Ideally, this would be a separate space than where they normally watch TV.



## Set Clear Expectations

Make sure students know what is expected of them at home while you are out. Schedule time to assist students with their learning.



## Create a Plan

Good planning can relieve stress for both children and parents. Check-in with your children about their plans and help them develop a written schedule not only for the day, but for the week. Help them prioritize their deadlines.



## Aeries Parent Portal

Make sure you can log in to your Aeries Parent Portal. Log in daily to check on student progress. Discuss assignments and attendance with your student.



## Communication

Talk to your student. Talk about what is going well and what they still need help on. Keep open lines of communication with teachers and their counselor.
