2. 2016-17 Division III CIF Baseball Champions – Pedro Carranza introduced the Div. III Baseball Team, and thanked the board for their support. He also thanked his coaching staff and student athletes for their dedication to academics first. He stated that the baseball players are held to a higher standard and therefore requires a higher GPA because they are students first and athletes second.
