Brawley Union High School Distinct Summer School
June 11 – July 3, 2018

Purpose: The Brawley Union High School Summer School Program is designed to allow students to make up failed courses and improve academic skills.

Enrollment: Students will sign up for summer school with their individual counselor on/or before May 9th, 2018. Course offerings depend on student requests, staffing, and funds. Class lists will be posted outside of the Counseling Center by June 1, 2018 or sooner. On the first day of summer school, June 11th, students must report to their class before 8:00am. ALL NEW STUDENTS and students not on the list should quietly proceed to the Counseling Center. If a student is not present on the first day of Summer School by 8:15am, his/her seat may be given to another student.

Duration: **BUHSD session – June 11th through July 3rd 8:00am to 2:30pm daily**
Lunch will be from 11:00 – 11:30am.

Attendance: Since time is short, attendance is extremely important. ANY STUDENT WHO IS **ABSENT THREE (3) TIMES WILL NOT RECEIVE CREDIT. TWO TARDIES EQUAL ONE ABSENCE.** Absences due to illness or any other reason will count towards the three absences. Any combination of tardies and absences that add up to three will result in removal from class. Students who enroll on Day 2 or Day 3 of summer school will already have 1 or 2 absences. Except for Westmorland, school buses will not operate during summer school. Students must arrange for their own transportation.

Please note: Any absences due to sports and/or sports camp, clubs, ASB, etc. are not excused. **There are no excused absences during summer school. Not being in class is considered an absence. Please plan vacation and activities accordingly.**

Meals: A nutritionally adequate meal for lunch will be provided for students that attend summer school. A cost may be assigned if a student doesn't qualify for Free or Reduced price.

Regulations: Regulations that are in effect during the regular school year will be in effect during summer school. A student who is uncooperative and fails to show a distinct interest in the school work will be dismissed. Time will not permit even an attempt to solve such problems. Discipline problems (class disruptions, excessive talking, defiance, etc.) will be handled by sending the student to the Administration Office where he/she will be sent home, the parent notified and one absence charged to the student's attendance. **ANY STUDENT WHO HAS THREE (3) ABSENCES WILL NOT RECEIVE CREDIT.** Students with discipline problems resulting in suspensions will be dismissed from summer school. In cases of mandated expulsion violations, the student will be recommended for expulsion. Please see Student handbook for discipline violations.
